

Premier Antenna Sites

Both of Broadcast Services' sites in Seattle, WA offer prime locations for antenna equipment.

The Columbia Center is the tallest building in downtown Seattle with a common area on the 73rd floor for land mobile radio equipment and other telecommunications systems. Standby electrical power facilities for transmitter plants can also be located in the building. This site is perfect for two-way, satellite and microwave communications.

First Hill Plaza boasts a clear view of the downtown area while an elevated penthouse allows mounting for directional panel antennas. This site can be used for two-way and microwave communication equipment. A fiber network is present and active at this site.
